

Rule 625 of KPM is a new provision laying down the procedure in a case in which the prisoner falls seriously ill during the period of his leave.

Rule 626 of KPM is a new provision regarding the steps to be taken when the prisoner released on leave dies during this period. Such provision is not found in the old rule.

Rule 627 of KPM is a new provision and it is also based on Chapter XXX of Model Prison Manual. A large number of prisoners are released on various kinds of leave every year. Occasions are sure to arise when a prisoner released on leave surrenders late or commits the breach of any condition of the released on leave. The new provision lays down the procedure to deal with such cases and the punishment for such offences.

Rule 628 of KPM is a new provision which insists the Superintendent to report to the Inspector General of Prison the date of return of prisoners released on leave.

Rule 629 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 452-BB.

#### CHAPTER XXXIV

#### APPEALS BY PRISONERS

Rule 630 of KPM is a new provision which is based on guidelines given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 631 of KPM covers the old rule 467 and 467A and is also intended to amplify the old rules.

Rule 632 of KPM is a modified version of old rule 468 and is based on the guidelines given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 633 of KPM. Further explains the old rule 470 and covers the period of limitation in various cases. It is also based on Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 634 of KPM is a modified version of old rule 471 and fully explains the procedure to be followed while forwarding appeal petitions to the appellate courts.

Rule 635 of KPM is a new provision based on the guidelines given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 636 of KPM is a new provision based on the guidelines given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.



Rule 637 of KPM is a new provision on special leave to appeal. It is based on the guidelines given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 638 of KPM is a new provision dealing with Court Martial cases. It is in accordance with the guidelines given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 639 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 472.

Rule 640 of KPM is a modified version of old rule 473 and is in accordance with the guidelines given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 641 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 649 and is in line with the recommendations given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

#### CHAPTER XXXV

#### PETITIONS TO GOVERNMENT FROM CONVICTS

Rule 642 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 474.

Rule 644 of KPM is an enlarged version of old rule 476 and is in accordance with the guidelines given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 645 of KPM is a new provision empowering the Superintendent to withhold a petition. This new provision is in line with the guidelines given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 646 of KPM is a new provision and it is in accordance with the provisions contained under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 647 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 477.

Rule 648 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 478.

Rule 649 of KPM is a new provision based on the guidelines given under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 650 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 479.

Rule 651 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 480.

Rule 693 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 512.

## CHAPTER XXXVIII

### RELEASE

Rule 705 of KPM. The old rules 521 and 522 have been combined to form the new rule.

Rule 706 of KPM is a new provision regarding the check date of convicts sentenced to imprisonment for life. The amendment under Section 433-A of Criminal Procedure Code is implied under this rule in respect of lifers.

Rule 707 of KPM. This is a new provision enabling the Superintendent to watch the check date of certain category of prisoners. It is based on Chapter XXVIII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 708 of KPM is also a new provision on the action to be taken in the case of release orders received by post.

Rule 709 of KPM is an enlarged version of old rule 523 and covers all aspects of the procedure prior to releasing a convict. This is also in accordance with the general provisions contained under Chapter XXVII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 710 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 524.

Rule 711 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 525.

Rule 712 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 526.

Rule 713 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 527.

The only difference being the addition of "Special Class Prisoners".

Rule 714 of KPM. This is a new provision concerning the release of prisoners undergoing treatment in outside hospitals. Since



the old rule is not very clear on this, introduction of a new provision is found necessary.

Rule 715 of KPM is a new provision on the release of prisoners suffering from contagious or dangerous disease. The old rules are silent on this point. Hence the necessity for introduction of the new rule.

Rule 716 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 529.

Rule 717 of KPM. This has been introduced to explain the procedure when the order of release is received direct from High Court. It is in a sense an expanded version of the note under old rule 529. The changes made the rule quite clear.

Rule 718 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 530.

Rule 719 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 531.

Rule 720 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 532.

Rule 721 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 533.

Rule 722 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 534.

Rule 729 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 541.

Rule 730 of KPM is a new provision regarding the release of female prisoners.

Rule 731 of KPM is a modified version of old rule 542.

Rule 732 of KPM pertains to the 3rd para of old rule 542 and certain additions have been introduced to make the rules specific.



## CHAPTER XXXIX

## AFTERCARE AND REHABILITATION

Rule 733 of KPM is a new provision explaining the essential elements and scope of aftercare help, in the case of discharged prisoners. This is in accordance with the guide-lines given under Chapter XXXVIII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 734 of KPM is also a new provision based on the provisions given under Chapter XXXVIII of Model Prison Manual.

Rule 735 of KPM is an enlarged version of old rule 528. The additional provisions have been incorporated based on the guide-lines given under Chapter XXXVIII of Model Prison Manual.

## CHAPTER XL

## ADVISORY BOARD

Rule 736 of KPM. This is a reproduction of old rule 553, with the addition of "Open Prison" is also made.

Rule 737 of KPM. This rule deals with the constitution of the Board. The old rule 544 has been partly included and the guide-lines given under Chapter VI of Model Prison Manual incorporated to frame this rule.

Rule 738 of KPM. The old rule 545 had to be modified to cover the principles contained in Chapter VI of Model Prison Manual, the amendment to Section 433 of Criminal Procedure Code and the Supreme Court Judgment dated 11-11-1980 in writ petition numbers 865/79, 641/80, 1177/80 etc. The new rule has been drafted accordingly. See also G. O. Rt. No. 284/80 Home dated 19-2-1980.

Rule 739 of KPM is largely based on the old rule 546 and certain provisions given under Chapter XXXVI of Model Prison Manual have also been included.

Rule 740 of KPM. This is a new provision detailing the procedure to be adopted for placing cases before the Advisory Board. Such details are lacking in the old rule.

Rule 741 of KPM. This is a new rule furnishing guide-lines to the Advisory Board Members as to the method of reviewing the cases of prisoners eligible for consideration. Such details are lacking in the old rules and therefore the members generally find it difficult to assess each case in the absence of proper guide-lines.

Rule 742 of KPM. This is an adoption of old rule 545 and framed in the light of a new provision under section 433A of Cr. P. C.

Rule 743 of KPM. This is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 545A.

Rule 744 of KPM is a new provision regarding the nature of disposal of each case by the State Governments on the recommendations of the Advisory Board.

Rule 745 of KPM is a modified version of old rule 547 and it is in accordance with G. O. MS. 49/76/Home dated 7-4-1976.

Rule 746 of KPM is a new provision regarding the premature release of prisoners by Courts in other States and offences in the Union List. Such a provision is not available in the old rule.

Rule 747 of KPM. This is a reproduction of old rule 548.

#### CHAPTER XLI

#### ARMOURY, ARMS ETC.

New rules 748, 749, 750, 751, 752, 753, 754 and 755 of KPM deal with Armoury, Custody of Arms, use of Arms, Annual indent for Arms, disposal of empty, cartridge cases, repair of Arms, Procedure of returning Arms, Ammunition etc. The old rules 559 and 562 have been considered besides the guidelines under Chapter XVI of Model Prison Manual, while drafting the new rule. The old rules were silent on many a point.

#### CHAPTER XLII

#### GUARDING

Rule 756 of KPM is a modified version of old rule 449.

Rule 757 of KPM is a modified version of old rule 550, making earlier provision more clear.

Rule 758 of KPM is a modified version of old rule 551.

Rule 759 of KPM is a modified version of old rule 552.

Rule 760 of KPM. Further amplifies the old rule 553.

Rule 761 of KPM. The old rule 554 has been suitably modified to suit the existing circumstances.



Rule 762 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 555, with additional information.

Rule 763 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 556.

Rule 764 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 557.

Rule 765 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 558.

Rule 766 of KPM is a modified form of old rule 559.

Rule 767 of KPM. This is a new provision enabling the Superintendent to draw up subsidiary rules for guidance of the Reserve Guard to meet local requirements.

Rule 770 of KPM is a new provision. The purport of the rule is to emphasise the importance of guarding arrangements from the Central Tower, wherever such building exists.

*Note:*—The old rule 562 "Arms and Ammunition, Warder Escort" has been incorporated with suitable additions under the Chapter XLI "Armoury and Arms etc." Hence there is no necessity to include this under the Chapter on "Guarding".

#### CHAPTER XLIII

#### CONFINEMENT IN IRON IN SECURITY

Rule 772 of KPM almost corresponds with the old rule No. 563, with small modification.

Rule 773 of KPM is almost a reproduction of old rule 564.

*Note:*—The old rule 565 need not be retained for the reason that the imposition of fetters is not given as a matter of routing either on transfer of prisoners or as a prison punishment. The imposition of fetters is resorted to only when a prisoner becomes violent and uncontrollable and not as a punishment for a Prison Offence. New Rule 773 is sufficient to cover this aspect.

The only change made here is the addition of "Superintendent or Police concerned" after Inspector General of Police.

Rule 786 of KPM covers the old rule 576 as well as an explanation to the old rule.

Rule 787 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 577.

Rule 788 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 581.

Rule 789 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 582.

Rule 790 of KPM is a reproduction of old rule 583.

Rule 791 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 584.

Rule 792 of KPM corresponds to the old rule 578. Variation has been effected in the matter of the quantum of reward in each case. The reward prescribed in the old rule being too low it requires enhancement as suggested in the new rule.

Rule 793 of KPM corresponds to the old rule 579. But there is variation in the amount of reward prescribed as in the case of new rule 792.

Rule 794 of KPM is a verbatim reproduction of old rule 580.
